



Ardmore's Inaugural Art From the Heart: Call for Artists

On Sunday, October 28, 2018, Ardmore Enterprises is hosting our Inaugural Art From the Heart Event at the Historic Oxon Hill Manor. This event will showcase and celebrate works created by artists with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Art will be auctioned off during the event with the artist receiving 50% of the auction price.

Please submit your work prior to 4:00 PM on Tuesday, September 18, to Ardmore Enterprises, 3000 Lottsford Vista Road, Bowie MD 20721. Unless art medium is photography, no digital submissions will be accepted.

Requirements

- All art must be original in concept, composition, and execution.
- Only artists with intellectual or developmental disability may submit works.
- All mediums are excepted; however art work must adhere to the following size criteria:
 - No more than 8 lbs. and no larger than 36"x36"
- All submission must be display ready: Two-dimensional work must be wired for hanging and either framed and mounted or matted.
- A panel will select pieces for display at the event. All selections are final.
- A maximum of 4 pieces of art may be submitted by each artist.

Other Information

- Artists will be notified by mail if their work is selected for display by 9/21/18.
- Selected art will be displayed and auctioned at Ardmore's Art From the Heart event at Oxon Hill Manor on 10/28/18 with the artist receiving 50% of the auction price.
- Selected art may be used to promote the event without compensation to the artist.
- Artists with work selected for display will receive two complimentary tickets to the Art from the Heart event.
- By submitting art for consideration, the artist understands that artwork is displayed at the owner's risk.
- Artists whose work is selected for exhibition must complete an Artist Contract.
- Art not selected must be picked up by Friday, 11/15, or it becomes property of Ardmore.
